### Are contributions towards my fundraiser tax deductible? Will contributors get receipts?

Yes and yes. Hopelink is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization and all donations are tax-deductible. For donations made online, remind your contributors to keep their email donation receipt as official record of their donation. For donations made via check, Hopelink will send a tax receipt to their mailing address. If your contributor is making a cash donation and would like a tax receipt, please be sure to record their contact information so a Hopelink representative can reach out.
