Orientation starts June 26

Program: July 14-August 22

- **FREE 6-week program** for intermediate level English students to prepare for the English for Work program in fall quarter
- Attend classes online on Zoom, or hybrid (online and in-person); morning or afternoon options available
- Supplemental in-person learning opportunities available at Hopelink Redmond or at a Seattle Public Library (location to be determined)
- Learn vocabulary and grammar related to job skills, career exploration, and job search
- **Program highlights:** Students receive individualized support, gain confidence speaking in English, and learn language skills, vocabulary, and technology skills essential for success in the fall program

Fall Quarter

Orientation starts August 26

Program: September 22-December 5

- **FREE 10-week program** for intermediate and advanced level English students
- Attend classes two times per week on Zoom; morning and evening options available
- Participate in supplemental in-person classes on Fridays at Hopelink Redmond or Rainier Beach Branch-Seattle Public Library
- Learning topics include resumes, job search, interviewing, and U.S. workplace
- **Program highlights:** Students receive 1-on-1 career advising, write resumes, and do practice job interviews with local employers
